Laney College occupies a beautiful 60-acre campus adjacent to the Oakland Museum and Lake Merritt BART Station. It is a short walk to historic Chinatown, scenic Lake Merritt, and the resurgent downtown Oakland.

Laney was founded in 1953. The college takes its name from Joseph C. Laney (1880-1948), a journalist, businessman, and former president of the Oakland Unified School District Board of Education. Laney joined the Peralta Community College District in 1964.

Today, Laney is the largest of the four Peralta campuses. The Peralta Community College District is comprised of Berkeley City College, College of Alameda, Laney College, and Merritt College.

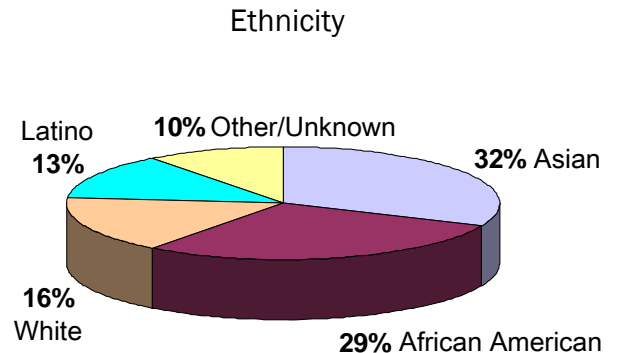
